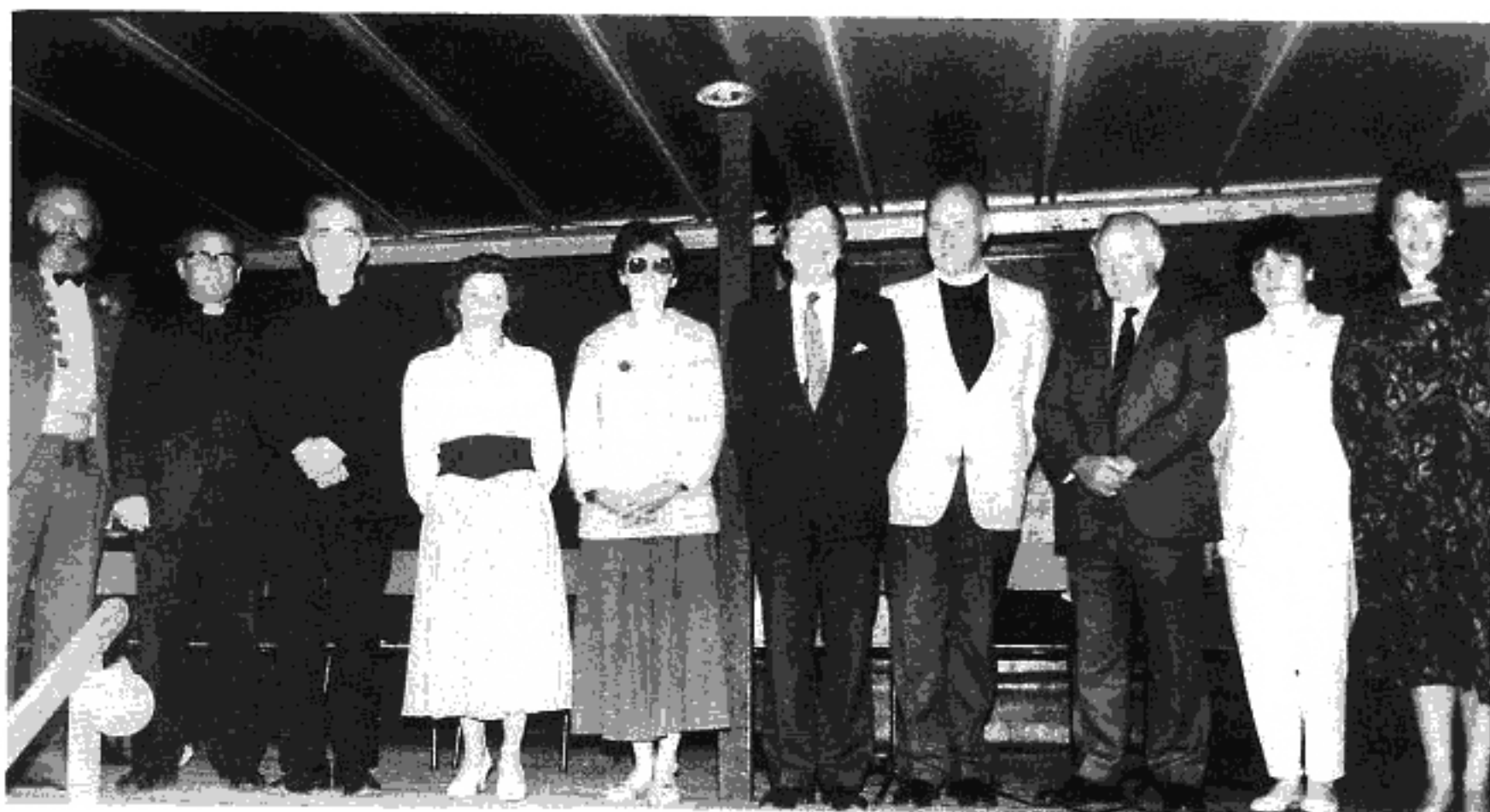


LEITRIM COASTAL FESTIVAL — TULLAGHAN
